Oregon Leather Pride Reimbursements

- CAP AIDS Walk is Sunday, September 22, 2013. Board members of Blackout Leather Productions are walking in the event.
- Show up at Pioneer Square at 10:00 a.m. The group photo will be taken shortly after 10:00 a.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

Guest-Oregon Bears, No guest was present.

Guest presentation by Master Bob

- Master Bob presented information about the Master/slave contest. He mentioned doing the
 event as an Oregon, Oregon/Washington or NW Region contest. He is looking for people
 who are living the Master/slave lifestyle. The title is an educational title focusing on the
 Master/slave relationship.
- The contest held in Oregon would be a feeder contest into the NW Region contest.
- Master Bob is looking at a joint venture with Blackout Leather Productions.
- Blackout Leather Productions would be involved by advertising, promoting, publicizing and soliciting contestants for the contest.
- There are three Mast chapters in Oregon and Washington. The contestants would come from other areas of the community and limited to five contestants.
- Master Bob would provide the seed money to get the contest started. He is looking to cover all the expenses for the titleholders or at least half of the expenses.
- The winners of the first year would fundraise money for the following year title winners.
- The titleholders must attend four events in their reining year.
- Contest date would be in conjunction with Sash Bash.

- The contestant interviews would be held in a public forum. Prior to the contest night the contestants would have a ten-minute presentation on master slave relationship. The audience may ask questions.
- On the night of the contest, the contestants would be given a pop question and have to give a two-minute answer.
- The Master/slave Contest is mostly a weekend event. There would be workshops on Master slave relationships. Meet and greet on Friday evening and the contest on Saturday evening. There would be a silent auction at the contest and on Sunday a brunch would be held with a silent auction. The contestants would be required to assemble a silent auction basket.

Blackout Leather Production Board Discussion

- What would be the relationship between BLP and the Master/slave contest? What do they want BLP to do? Justin does not want the Master/slave contest to be a part of Sash Bash. Dominic agrees.
- Thom likes the idea of helping with the contest but not fully operate the contest.
- BLP would consider the social aspect of the weekend and Master Bob organize the contest.

Coronation 2013

- Dominic made a motion to increase the Coronation ticket budget from \$50.00 to \$65.00 an increase of \$15.00. Brent seconded the motions and the board members present carried the motion; Gary Klein was absent.
- The attire for the evening is high leather.
- Thom is attending the Coronation along with the titleholders. Tobin, Justin, Dominic, and boy kevin is attending as members of BiLs and will be assisting with stair duties.
- BLP will run a half-page ad in the Coronation program. Thom agreed to buy a full-page ad for \$150.00 and donate half of the page to Blackout Leather Productions. The ad needs to be submitted by September 30, 2013. Brent will design the layout of the ad.

Sash Bash 2014

- Dominic would like to reinvent Sash Bash. Create a weekend around education, socializing and play. Make Sash Bash relevant and current. More fluid and dirty.
- More people need to be drawn into the events.
- Keep the events simple, have the cigar social and a cigar demo in a casual setting.
- The current Sash Bash has lost itself over time. Tobin mentioned getting back to basics with Sash Bash; remove the fundraising from the weekend. Make the weekend more assessable to the community.
- The committee members, Dominic, Tobin, Brent and boy kevin will meet for a half hour after the October meeting to start formulating ideas on reinventing the 2014 Sash Bash.
- Tobin mentioned a possible name change. "Back to Black"
- The board of BLP wants to keep the brunch on Sunday.

Website Hosting

- The web-hosting fee has increased to \$30.00 per month, \$10.00 per domain name.
- BLP has committed to pay for an additional three months and there is one month remaining.
- Justin mentioned "GoDaddy" webhosting. It is \$8.99 per month with 24/7phone support. Unlimited websites and unlimited Data basis

- Brent mentioned "Squarespace" webhosting. The monthly fee is \$8.00.
- Justin is going to compare and contrast the two web hosting sites and report back to the BLP board.
- A decision needs to be made by the end of October.
